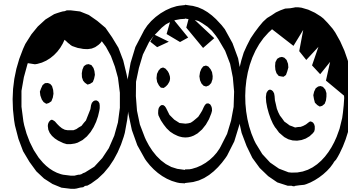

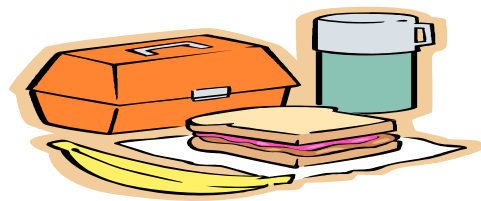

Next P & C meeting is 15 June at 7.00 pm in the staff room. Some of the things on the agenda will be:

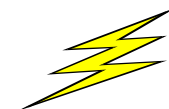
